

Presentation Type Descriptions

- **Oral Presentation:** This is a presentation in a concurrent breakout session shared with other presenters with different perspectives and research on a similar topic.
- **Poster Presentation:** Both in person and virtual posters will be accepted.
- **Ignite Talk:** 5-minute presentation with no more than 20 PowerPoint Slides, this is a fast-paced presentation that typically gets right to the results of your research or presents a new or emerging idea or research.
- **Deep Dive:** This is a longer, more in-depth session that may be concurrent with other presentations.
- **Other:** We look forward to your suggestions of other types of presentations, be creative and propose a new idea.
